

2009 Supplemental Rules for ATV Dirt Track

* a new rule for 2009

1. All competition number plates MUST be white (minimum 8" x 10") with black numbers. No letters or stickers with the exception of earned National "N" can be placed on the front number plate. ATV front number plates must be vertical to the front end of the ATV, and there must be one on each side as well as on the back.
2. All riders must use the last two digits of their AMA number, or the single digit earned in that class the previous year. Three digit numbers are not allowed.
3. Knobby tires are not allowed on dirt track ATVS.
4. Four wheeler classes:
 - Four-stroke class for trophies
 - Quad B (250- 450cc) two and four stroke for trophies
 - Open quad for two and/or four strokes for trophies (ATV or single cylinder m/c engines)
 - Open A Quad: 265-450cc 2 stroke and/or four stroke for trophies
 - An Open Dash class will also be offered (also two and/or four stroke). * **Winner take all if less than 5 riders; otherwise pay the top three.**
 - Youth ATV classes for riders 4 through 12. Ages 4-12; 90cc Production machinery; automatic transmissions; in a mini quad chassis;
5. Points are issued 20-16-13-11-10-9-8, etc. down to four for all classes. To receive points, riders must be on the line for the start of the semi or final event. Those eliminated from the final through a semi will receive four participation points for their day's efforts.
6. A late sign-up fee, up to double the normal entry fee, may be charged.
7. A decibel meter will be used to ensure all entrants are within legal limits. (99DBA)
8. All races must be sanctioned before February 1st to be considered District points paying events.
9. Practice times should be printed on all schedules, and the official schedule will be the single handout sheet, not the printed events book.
10. * **Practice tickets are to be given for each entry, not for each machine.**
